



MINNESOTA NHL ALUMNI SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM CRITERIA & ELIGIBILITY

Minnesota High School Hockey Player Estimates:

- 8 sections of "AA" boys - 8 sections of "AA" girls - 8 sections of "A" boys - 4 sections of "A" girls
- 162 boy's high school teams - 122 girl's high school teams
- Approximately 6,000 high school players - 1,500 seniors - 80% to 85% (1,200-1,250) will go to college.

Criteria/Eligibility To Be Considered For Scholarship:

- ✚ Senior High School age Player a) - with a minimum GPA of 3.0 (B- to C+)
b) - or a special circumstance student
- ✚ Not receiving a Scholarship exceeding ¼ of tuition
- ✚ Community Involvement
- ✚ Letters of Recommendation from: a) Coach
b) Teacher other than coach
c) Community Leader
- ✚ Completed NHL Alumni Scholarship Application
- ✚ One-page typed letter of request from applicant stating reasons for wanting scholarship

Scholarship will be based on a combination of athletic and academic achievements

Selection Committee:

- Up to ten member selection committee with Minnesota NHL Alumni participation
- Partner with the Minnesota High School Boys & Girls Hockey Coaches Associations & Minnesota Hockey
- Scholarship will be based on a combination of athletic and academic achievements

Amount of scholarships:

- \$1,000 each year for 4 years (each student could receive \$4,000 over the four-year scholarship period)

Requirements for 2nd, 3rd & 4th years:

- Must reapply each year with transcripts. It is the responsibility of each recipient to reapply for years 2, 3 & 4
- Must continue to be a full time student
- Must achieve a GPA of: 2.5 GPA in 1st yr, with no failing grades
2.7 GPA in 2nd yr, with no failing grades
2.8 GPA in 3rd yr, with no failing grades
